- Faith as defined in the bible is about assurance and convictions. – [Hebrews 11:1](#)
- When faith is at work in your life it dips into your soul. [Galatians 2:20](#)
- Belief vs Faith
  - In some respect belief and faith have been used interchangeably but in modern English they don't mean the same thing.
  - Greek word used in the case of John is the word "pisteuo" and it the more popular word translated to "believe" in the NT which mean "to have faith"
  - Greek word used for "belief" is the word pistis which means persuasion or credence.
- Faith is the intellectual acceptance of facts which is proven by the actions that displays trust and commitment to those facts.

## Faith it Until You Make It.

- Our spiritual journey with God starts with faith [Hebrews 11:6](#)
  - it's sustained by faith, and it's judged by faith.
- The various dimensions of faith manifest itself in the works we do. [James 2:17, Hebrews 11:29-32](#)
- Faith increases with time and experiences with God.
- A faith that is not exercised cannot be trusted.

Faith is the assurance of thing hoped for and the conviction of things not yet seen. God works in faith and through faith.
