- 3. Find people who are grateful for what God has done for them and practice service with them. Luke 17:15-16
- 4. Your service to God will not look like everyone else, but in all you do, do it to honor God! 1 Corinthians 10:31
- 5. God is looking for a willing and genuine heart to serve Him, not a performative heart. Acts 8:9,13,18-23
